And the real question would be why I would want to walk around like that in the first place?

What does it say about me, and my respect for God if I look like (dress like) I'm in a gang (and that's what I want others to think), or I'm dressing like Lady Gag (I know her name!) with little to nothing on in an attempt to look sexy. Maybe I talk like one of the guys on the shift, or laugh at dirty jokes on a company lunch break. There are more important things in life than trying to live like (look like, talk like) worldly people.
