1900 Federal Census, Household 285, Family 294, Jefferson Township, Osage County, Missouri; Charles **Courtwright**, shown as age 9, is living with Aunt and Uncle John and Cassie (Elzia Marie **Hancks**) **Thompson**.

1910 Federal Census, Household 175, Family 180, Crawford Township, Osage County, Missouri; Charles **Courtwright**, age 19, is a "hired hand" in the household of Lee **Jett**.

1910 Federal Census, Household 8, Family 8, Hattie Jane **Pointer**, age 23, is in the household of her parents, Frantz S. and Emma **Pointer**.

On November 27, 1912, Charles **Courtwright** married Hattie Jane **Pointer**, daughter of Frank (Frantz) **Pointer** and Emma G. **Owens Pointer**.

World War I Draft Registration, Charles **Courtwright** is married with three children living in Cooper Hill, Missouri working as a tie maker.

1920 Federal Census, Household 8, Family 8, Jefferson Township, Osage County, Missouri; Charley **Courtwright**, son-in-law and children "Gurty", Arthur and Roy are in the household of Frank **Pointer**.

1930 Federal Census, First Ward, Jefferson City, Missouri; Household 1201, Charles **Courtwright** is a boarder and working as a guard at the state prison.

1930 Federal Census, Jefferson Township, Osage County, Missouri; Household 52, Family 57, Geneva G., Burl and Roy F. **Courtwright** are living with their grandparents, Frank S. and Emma G. **Pointer**.
