Marshall Ready Dies At Vienna Home

Marshall **Ready** of Star Route 1, Vienna, died Wednesday, Nov. 4, 1981, at his residence after suffering an apparent heart attack at the age of 78.

Mr. **Ready** was born June 29, 1903, in Maries County, the son of Richard and Millie (Mollie) **Ridenhour Ready**. He was a life-long resident of Maries County; he was a self-employed carpenter for all of his working life.

He was preceded in death by his parents and by an infant sister.

Survivors include two brothers, Henry **Ready** of Vienna, Ray **Ready** of Hannibal; four nephews, Corbett **Ready** of Florissant, Gerald **Ready** and Dean **Ready**, both of Vienna, and Roger **Ready** of Taos; a niece, Georgia Lea **Cassmeyer** of Oklahoma City; six great-nephews; and three great-nieces.

Funeral services were conducted Saturday, Nov. 7, at the Birmingham-Martin Funeral Chapel in Vienna, with the Rev. Cellis **Crum** of the Little Flock Baptist Church near Vienna officiating. Robert **Crum** sang "In The Garden" and "In The Sweet By And By"; he was accompanied by Ruth **Hendricks**.

Interment was at the Pilot Knob cemetery near Summerfield, under the direction of Birmingham-Martin. Pallbearers were Corbett **Ready**, Gerald **Ready**, Dean **Ready**, Roger **Ready**, Greg **Ready** and Doug **Ready**.
