Harry "Bill" E. **Holden**, 77, of Centertown, Missouri, formerly of Springfield, Missouri, passed away Friday, August 15, 2008, in his home. He was born January 13, 1931, in Springfield, Missouri, a son of the late Harry W. and Bernice (**Skates**) **Holden**.

He graduated from Springfield Senior High School (now Central High School), in Springfield, Missouri. He also graduated from the University of Missouri in Rolla, with a degree in physics and electrical engineering. Bill enlisted in the United States Air Force in 1952, and was accepted at West Point Academy. He worked for Air Research in the Los Angeles, Calif. area until returning to school, graduating from Law School at the University of Missouri in Columbia around 1970.

During his law career, he worked for the Missouri Department of Agriculture, the Missouri Public Service Commission and the Division of Employment Security as an Administrative Judge. He retired in 1990.

He is survived by three daughters, Julie **Holden** of Springfield, Linda **Nolen** of Lebanon and Sheryl **Eveler** (husband Gary) of Centertown; one brother, David **Holden** (wife Betty) of Springfield; five grandchildren, James **Lewis** of Columbia, Teddy **Nolen** of Kansas City, Andrea **Funkhouser** of Springfield, Lindsey **Eveler** of Centertown and Kaylee **Eveler** of Centertown; and four great-grandchildren.
