the village school. In 1920 she is listed as a housekeeper in a
private dwelling.
The Federal Census records from 1910 and 1920 indicate that
Anne E. **Luster** had five children, all living, the 1900 Federal
census list six children, five living at that time.

- "Dora **Adler** and Stella **Luster** entertained their little friends
Monday evening, in honor of their eighth birthday at the home of
Mr. and Mrs. **Luster**. Quite a number of young merry-makers were
present, and all who were present went away highly pleased with
the evening's entertainment."
