Funeral services for Mrs. Ella Lucille **Luster**, who died Sunday at a local nursing home, were conducted Wednesday morning at 11:00 o'clock at the Chapel of Burke-Jones Funeral Home with Rev. Ray **Evans** and Rev. Jim **Forkner** officiating. Interment was in Fort Gibson National Cemetery.

Funeral services for William L. **Luster**, 63, were conducted Tuesday morning at 10:00 a.m. at the chapel of Burke-Jones Funeral Home with Rev. Jim **Forkner**, pastor of the First Presbyterian Church, officiating. Burial was at Fort Gibson National Cemetery.

A retired salesman, **Luster** was a veteran of World War I, and had established a residence at the U.S. War Veterans Colony south of here, where he had been for the past five years. He was born on April 29, 1897 to Springer, Okla. He died on July 19 while visiting in Downey Calif. He was a member of the Church of Christ. Organizations which he was a member of included the American Legion, Disabled War Veterans and Veterans of Foreign Wars.
