Death Comes to Robert Poe

Funeral services were held Friday afternoon at the **Poe** home near Belle for Robert I. **Poe**, son of William P. and Mary A. **Poe**, who died at his home Wednesday. He was seventy two years of age and had been ill for a year.

Mr. **Poe** was married March 20, 1892 to Miss Eliza Caroline **Shockley**, who, with one son Bryce **Poe** of Kansas City, survives him.
