The following was derived from microfilm records of the Office of the Adjutant General, State of Missouri:

Enlisted Pvt. Co. E, Steen's Reg't (10th) Missouri Infantry, CSA, Thomasville, MO August 8, 1862 by Col. **Johnson** for a period of three years. Died of wounds received at the battle of Prairie Grove, December 7, 1862. Everett **King** in his "History of Maries County" says that Isaac was killed in 1864 and Bryce I in his writing says he was killed at Pea Ridge, Arkansas and "probably" buried at Wilson's Creek. This is the family tradition that was passed on to me by my mother; however the military records do not support that tradition. Prairie Grove, Arkansas was the site of a battle in late fall 1862 between the Union and the Confederacy.
