Barney **Johnson** married Alice **Jennings**, widow of George Robert
Jennings from Claiborne Co., TN born in the 1860's, wife Alice **Satterfield** m. c.
1895, lived around Rogers Ark, their three children: Newt, Howard and Walter.
He died c. 1902. Alice then married Barney **Johnson** and they moved to Big
Cabin OK Craig County, Barney and Alice had five children, Kirk, Al, Jack,
Rusty, Verna...We have been lead to believe that Barney may have lived around
Claiborne Co., TN prior to marrying Alice. We also know that Barney had
brothers and sisters. Cleve, lived in LA Calif. in 1942, and Georgia M. **Reem**
(lived in Washington in 1942). Bob lived in LA Calif. 1942, Jennie M. **Kirk** lived
in Kansas City). Died in a house fire.

Obituaries

Barney M. **Johnson**, 78 years old, was burned to death Saturday night in a fire which destroyed his home, 11 miles southwest of Vinita.

The fire was discovered by his son Kirk, who arrived too late to assist in getting the aged Craig Countian from the house.

Origin of the fire has not yet been determined, but it was presumed that Mr. **Johnson** was trapped in the house after falling asleep. His body was burned beyond recognition.

Survivors are four sons, Al of Brawley, CA, Jack of San Diego, CA, Clarence of Vinita, and Kirk of the home; one daughter, Mrs. Verna **Black** of San Diego; two brothers, Cleve and Bob, both of Los Angeles; and two sisters, Mrs. Jennie **Kirk** of Kansas City and Mrs. Georgia **Reed** of Washington.

Funeral services will be held at 3:00 Tuesday afternoon at the Christian Church in Big Cabin with Rev. Ed **Foreman** officiating.

Burial will be made in the Big Cabin Cemetery under the direction of the Burckhalter Funeral Home.
