“Know all men by these presents, that we Joseph **Schwegler** and Anna **Schwegler**, wife of said Joseph **Schwegler** of the County of Gasconade in the State of Missouri, have, this day, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand, dollars, to the said Joseph **Schwegler** in hand paid by Diedrich **Weidemann** of the County of Gasconade in the State of Missouri, granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Diedrich **Weidemann** the following described tracts or parcels of land, situate in the County of Gasconade, in Missouri; that is to say:

The northwest qr of northeast qr, northeast qr of northwest qr, northwest qr of northwest qr of section sixteen (16) and the southwest qr of southwest qr, southwest gr of southeast qr of section nine (9), township forty three (43), range (6) west, containing two hundred acres more or less.

Deed and Mortgage Continued:

To have and to hold the promises hereby conveyed, with all the rights, privileges and appurtenances belonging, or in anywise appertaining, unto the said Dederick **Weideman**, his heirs and assigns forever, upon this express condition:

Whereas, the said Joseph **Schwegler**, on the fourth day of October, 1866 made, executed and delivered to the said Dederich **Weidemann** certain promissory note, in words and figures follow, to-wit:

Gasconade County, October 4th, 1866

Four years after date I promise to pay to Dederich **Weidemann** on order the sum of one thousand dollars for value received, negotiable and payable with refutation or discount and with interest from date at the rate of seven per cent per annum.

Joseph **Schwegler** (*seal*) Anne **Schwegler** (*seal*)

Now if said Joseph **Schwegler** dies executor or administrator, shall pay the sum of money specified in said note, and all the interest that may be due thereon, according to the tenor and effect of said note, then this conveyance shall be void, otherwise it shall remain in full force and virtue in law.

And the said Dederich **Weidemann**, or his executor, or administrator may proceed to sell the property herein before described, or any part thereof, at public vendue, to the highest bidder, at the court house, in the County of Gasconade for cash in hand, first giving thirty days public notice of the time, terms and place of sale, and of the property to be sold, by advertisement (in some newspaper printed or circulated in the County where the premises are situate) and upon such sale, and the payment of the purchase money shall execute and deliver a conveyance of the property so sold, to the purchaser thereof; and any statement of fact or recital by the said Dederich **Weidemann** in such conveyance in relation to the advertisement, sale, receipt of the purchase money, or execution of such conveyance, shall be received as prima facie evidence of the truth thereof. And the said Dederich **Weidemann** shall, with the proceeds of the sale aforesaid, pay, first, the expenses of this trust, and next, whatever may be in arrears or unpaid on said note, whether of principal or interest, and the balance (if any) shall be paid over to the said Joseph **Schwegler** or his legal representative.

Be It Remembered, that Joseph **Schwegler** and Anna **Schwegler** his wife, who are personally known to the undersigned, a Justice of the Peace within and for said County, to be the persons whose names are subscribed to the foregoing Deed, as parties thereto, this day, appeared before me and acknowledged that they executed and delivered the same as their voluntary act and deed, for the uses and purposes therein contained. And the said Anna **Schwegler** being by me made acquainted with the contents of said Deed, acknowledged, on an examination apart from her said husband, that she executed the same, and relinquishes her dower in the real estate therein mentioned, freely, and without compulsion or undue influence of her said husband.

"State of Missouri, County of Gasconade: Before the Clerk of the Circuit Court appeared Joseph **Schwegler**, a native of Switzerland, aged 36 years, who being duly sworn upon his oath, that it is bona fide his intention to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce and abjure forever all allegiance to every foreign Power, Prince, State and Sovereignty whatsoever and particularly to the Republic of Switzerland of whom he is at present subject."

Gasconade County, Boulware Township, (Anna **Hesse**, 1027 Stone Hill, Herman, MO 65041):

"**Leimkuehler** Families (including Anna M.; Joseph **Schwegler**'s third wife) buried in Cemetery #31 located just off BB highway north of Mt. Sterling, Sec. 7, T43N, R6W. Hann **Schwegler** is buried in Cemetery #23, just off Fowler Rd. between Bay and U.S. 50; Sec. 3, T43N, R6W. Boulware Township borders the east side of Osage County on the west."

Transcribed from a history of the **Leimkuehler** family, page 6

"As a single man Frederick **Leimkuehler** lived in a log house on a small tract of land which became later a part of father's farm or the F. W. **Leimkuehler** farm. Later in life he married Mrs. Anna **Kalteweihr** Schwegler, nee **Fehner**. They lived first on what later was known as the William **Brinkman** farm on Pin Oak Creek. Their last years of life were spent in Lafayette County, Missouri."
